Key Fire Prevention Tips

- 1. Keep Matches and Lighters Away: Always store matches, lighters, and other flammable materials out of reach of children. Teach them that these items are not toys and should only be used by adults.
- 2. Install Smoke Alarms: Ensure that smoke alarms are installed on every level of your home, especially inside bedrooms and outside sleeping areas. Test them monthly and replace batteries at least once a year
- 3. Teach Escape Routes: Show children two ways to escape from every room in the house. Practice fire drills at least twice a year, ensuring they know where to meet outside.
- 4. Crawl Low Under Smoke: In case of a fire, teach kids to stay low to the ground to avoid smoke inhalation. Crawling helps them breathe better and see more clearly.
- 5. Stop, Drop, and Roll: If their clothes catch fire, children should know to stop what they are doing, drop to the ground, and roll to extinguish the flames.
- 6. Stay Out Once Out: Emphasize the importance of not going back inside a burning building for any reason, including pets or belongings. Once they are outside, they should stay outside.
- 7. Know the Sound of the Alarm: Teach children what the smoke alarm sounds like and what actions to take when they hear it. They should alert an adult immediately or follow their escape plan.
- 8. Practice Fire Safety Games: Engage children with interactive games and challenges that teach fire safety skills in a fun way. For example, the American Red Cross offers "Pedro's Fire Safety Challenge" for younger kids.
- 9. Educate About Hot Surfaces: Teach kids to stay away from hot surfaces like stoves, heaters, and candles to prevent burns.
- 10. Create a Fire Safety Plan: Work together to create a family fire safety plan, including escape routes and a designated meeting spot outside.

By instilling these fire prevention tips in children, you can help them understand the importance of fire safety and prepare them to act appropriately in case of an emergency. Regular practice and reinforcement of these lessons will ensure they are well-equipped to handle fire-related situations safely.







